## 084. Fall from Top Spin type ride

A report has been received by NAFLIC of the death of a woman and serious injury to another after they fell from a Top Spin type fairground ride in the city of Penjao in central Mexico. According to the report, the riders involved were a mother, aged 50, and her daughter, aged 26, who both fell 33ft from the ride after a safety bar failed. The mother died at the scene while at the time of the report, the daughter was in a critical condition in hospital. Investigations into the cause of the incident were continuing at the time of writing.
