096. Formula XXXX Type Rides - Idees Loisirs S.A.

Howson Inspection Services and Systems & Safety Consultancy have lotified us of several problems that they have encountered with some of the Formula serves lates from Idées Loisirs. There are several types of these popular devices and a faults cannot may not appear on all versions.

- 1. The connections to the "traffic light" a sets in the centre of the ride are supplied as open connector blocks, and as this area is open to the lements, consideration should be given to replacing these connectors with war and types.
- 2. The same comment applies to a chashing lights a fixed to the railings, where open connector blocks are used. These can easily be calched, and should also be replaced with waterproof enclosed to pe
- 3. The railings referred to above are detached and are held in place by gravity and a tight fit. A more substant prethod of fixing would be desirable, to prevent accidental removal of the railings
- 4. These railings can be considered as extraneous notatwork, and if so, should be provided with an earth bonding conductor.
- 5. In the electrical vittingear care sets within the colerators box, there are bare terminals, that present a show hazara, went the doors at open. The Appointed Person should consider measures of ensure of that these similars can not be touched accidentally by adequate a stanton and provision of locks to the cabinet doors.
- 6. In some cases, the earth a kage protect of devices have a higher trip current rating than SuA as recommended in the last of Safe Practice. Appointed Persons should consider whether such shock protection provided is adequate.
- 7. It say cases the main income supply cables have been found to have pulled loose from the contection point outside the operators box, leaving bare live conductors and pearth income.

 This are should be checked thoroughly during examinations.
