Fort Fun Trapper Slider injury

A 12-year-old boy is reported to have injured his leg in an accident at the Fort Fun theme park in Germany in October 2017. The incident occurred on the Trapper Slider attraction, a gravity-driven alpine coaster ride. For reasons unknown at the time of the report, the boy's foot got caught between the sled and the tracks of the mountain coaster, causing a serious injury to his leg.

NAFLIC notes that there are not many of these attractions in the UK and provides this bulletin for information purposes.
