088. Swing ride collapse

NAFLIC has received a report of a 16-seater swing ride collapsing at the Askari Amusement Park, in Karachi, Pakistan, the incident resulting in the death of a 14-year-old girl and injuries to 15 other people. According to the report, the initial investigation into the accident said "broken bolts" were to blame but at the time of writing this had yet to be confirmed .
