095. Inflatable blown over in China

NAFLIC has received a report of a bouncy castle with a number of children on it being blown upside down by a gust of wind in a Chinese city in February. It was reported that three children were injured, two seriously, in the incident which took place in Guizhou Province, south-east China.

Footage shared on social media shows one side of the inflatable being lifted off the ground by the wind, flipping the entire structure over.
