Water tested at park for micro-organisms

NAFLIC has been made aware of a report published at the end of July 2019 relating to water in a waterpark at a theme park being tested for harmful micro-organisms after a number of children apparently came down with severe diarrhoea and vomiting.

The venue in question was Twinlakes in Leicestershire and the report states that the waterpark was shut while Public Health England investigated the outbreak. The report also states that approximately 30 children on a school trip were affected, with some adults becoming ill too.

The Health and Safety Executive and the local council were also working with the park to investigate the incident.
