358. Covered bases on fixed structures

The bases / foundations of fixed structures such as roller coasters & log flumes etc are in some instances obscured by back-filling the area with the surrounding earth. In some cases the bases may be in or under water. This is often to the detriment of the structure as the conditions accelerate corrosion which may go undetected. AIB's should satisfy themselves that the condition of the device, including the support structure, has not deteriorated to an extent that may cause danger and should therefore ensure that such areas are exposed in order to complete an annual thorough examination.
