Ride: GIANT GONDOLA WHEEL Subject: EMERGENCY BRAKE USE

The Chance Rides, Inc. GIANT GONDOLA WHEEL amusement ride is equipped with an emergency air-operated brake. This emergency brake is attached to the outside of the operator's control stand and is intended to be used in an emergency situation such as in the event of a loss of power to the ride.

If power is lost, the ride will coast to a stop. The emergency brake can then be applied. If power is not restored, the passengers can be unloaded by manually rotating the ride. In such an emergency situation, unload only two gondolas at a time to keep the wheel balanced.

In addition to the emergency procedure outlined above, Chance Rides, Inc. requires the emergency brake to be set during the installation of gondolas to the ride and removal of gondolas from the ride. This provides protection in the case of a power failure to personnel who are working around and between the gondolas.
